4. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN

Cllr Leigh proposed Cllr Sadler for election as Chairman; this was seconded by Cllr Bellis.

Nothing to report other than potholes, drains and gully clearing needing attention from CWAC.

The meeting concluded at 8. 10pm.

CLUTTON: Meeting commenced 8.10pm.

Cllr Johnson raised continued concerns regarding the speed limit past the school. He had discussed how dangerous it was at a recent meeting with the Samara Trust CEO. Signage was also not adequate and dirty. Resolved: Cllr

Johnson to ask CWAC to clean the signage. Clerk to ask PCSO to deploy the police speed gun.

A request for funding towards the upcoming Jubilee celebration was requested. Resolved: On the full May agenda for discussion following this meeting.

Drains at Chowley continued to be a problem. Resolved: Cllr Johnson to report to CWAC again.
